### Principal's Report

I would like to welcome you all to the 2016 school year. I hope all of you had a restful and rejuvenating break.

This year promises to be both engaging and busy with many of the Education State reforms coming into effect. The KTHS School Community will also be developing a Strategic Plan which will map out the School's future direction over the next four years. This is an exciting time to be a part of Kerang Technical High School with the opportunity to influence the outcomes of individual students to ensure that students excel, not only in academic subjects, but that they are also supported in being confident, resilient and happy.

Also this year we will be working toward commencing the building works as the planning is well under way. A few "kinks" still need to be worked out before this process can begin and we are in negotiations with the Education Department about asbestos removal. This process is about getting as much for the funding we have been provided for so that current and future students of Kerang Technical High School have the best facilities possible.

Along with building the best facilities possible, we would like to ensure every student has access to the most up-to-date computer technology, hardware and software available. The cost of modernising this equipment all at once is in excess of \$300,000. This is a figure the school cannot sustain so a computer plan has been developed where we roll over existing eLearning Technologies in a three year cycle. To facilitate this along with the school contributions we have introduced an essential eLearning levy under the banner of a computer surcharge. This money along with money contributed by the school will be used for new computers, servers and software which students will see the benefit of very soon.

The year has started at a fast pace and there is a lot happening in the first few weeks. Added to this, we have seven new teachers starting.

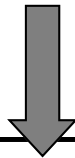
