PRINCIPAL'S REPORT IFARM:

The Agriculture Program at KTHS has received a number of boosts that will progress Agriculture at KTHS. The ifarm is up and running with its first crop planted. With its technology students will be able to control remotely the amount of water and fertilizer to each bay making it possible to assess what impact different amounts have on the plants. This can also be administered remotely by the teacher from home and as it is off the grid any power failures have no effect. At the start of the year the school received a Grant for \$100,000 which

will be used to buy a tractor and put up a new shed. The tractor has been ordered and should be here soon. Then there is the Farming and Agricultural Expo planned for 7th of June. This will show case farming in the district with Agricultural displays and presentations. Other secondary schools as



far away as Swan Hill and East Loddon will be attending. Students and the school community owe this all to the hard work of Krystal Grills the Agricultural Teacher. A big thank you to Krystal for all the opportunities and experiences she is giving students at KTHS.

GRADE 6 to YEAR 7 TRANSISTION:

It seems early that I am talking about Grade 6 to Year 7 transition, but it is already well under way. So far, the Parent Information Session has been held and Information Packs have been distributed. Over the last two weeks Open Day tours of the school have been conducted. Today is the first Transition Day with students from Kerang South and Murrabit spending an entire day at school attending taster Year 7 classes. Throughout the next week more Transition Day tasters will be conducted for Kerang Primary. Koondrook and St Joes.

Winter Uniform.

KTHS has a winter uniform which can be found in the student diary. We have tried to make it as flexible as possible including jumpers, jackets, shorts and pants to cater for the student needs.
