PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

GRAND PRIX:

STAFFING:

To cover these positions the school has employed six new staff members Colleen Mathew in the kitchen, Natalie, Melanie and Ken as our new cleaners, Hannah Aumann in Science and Jane Todd as a Generalist teacher who specialises in VCD and Art.

VET PROGRAM - Ms JULIE PEARCE:

One of the strengths for the students at KTHS is our VET Program. Most schools our size need to outsource the VET subjects which means students take a day to travel to a town that has TAFE available. Traveling for the day limits to one the number of VET subjects a student can do and means that they miss timetabled classes on that day. KTHS has the VET subjects integrated into the timetable making it possible for students to do more than one VET subject at KTHS. The school is very fortunate to have the VET staff we do. As part of being able to teach VET, staff are required to maintain industry currency. This means they must spend time at a workplace related to the area they teach. Last week Ms Julie Pearce spent a day at the Kerang Hospital working in the kitchen. One of her tasks was to make 2kgs of yoyo's! This type of professional development is a win for staff because they maintain contact with their industry and a win for the workplace because they get a great worker for the day and have some contact with the school.

PUPIL FREE DAY- Monday, 24th April: First day back Term Two, there will be one of the two Professional Practice Days that every school is entitled to, one in Semester One and one in Semester Two. Staff will use this time to work on their curriculum both for planning and correction. It also ties in with the ANZAC Day Public Holiday on Tuesday, 25th April. 




Fill in your email and mobile details and then review all details before confirming your registration


