## PRINCIPAL'S REPORT

### YEAR 7 INFORMATION NIGHT:

On Monday, 22nd, we held our Year 7 information night and this was very well attended and received by parents/guardians and students. The purpose of the night was to inform parents/guardians and students of what was available at KTHS. It included available classes, Inclusion and how that looks for all new students and Wellbeing presentations. As a new parent what you want to know is does my child have access to a range of subjects, how will they be looked after and what will you do to assist my child's learning? These were addressed on the night and opportunity was provided at the end for questions of which a lot of parents remained to ask. Well done to Miss Ferrier and her team on the nights presentation.

### RYAN LARKIN CONTINUES TO IMPRESS WITH HIS MOTORBIKE RACING:

The R3 Asia-Pacific Championship was introduced in 2024 to foster emerging talent in the Asia-Pacific region, drawing 21 riders from across six nations – including Oceania young guns Ryan Larkin from Australia and Haydn Fordyce from New Zealand – who are taking the next step in their careers via the intensive Yamaha training, mentoring and development program.

The championship, which utilises identical race-prepped Yamaha YZF-R3s, will be held over six rounds in 2024 across circuits in Thailand, Japan and Australia.

Round one was held at the Chang International Circuit in Thailand on April 5-7, with the top five in both races separated by just half a second.

Larkin's 2-4 scorecard in round one has him sitting equal second in the championship, behind Japan's Kakeru Okunuki in first place. Larkin is also a competitor in the Australian Supersport 300 Championship, so the 17-year-old from Gonn Crossing in Victoria will likely be on double duties at The Bend – a superb 18-turn layout which will provide the Yamaha R3 bLU cRU Asia-Pacific Championship riders with myriad passing opportunities.



### ANZAC SERVICE:

KTHS conducted its ANZAC memorial service on Wednesday 24<sup>th</sup> of April. The day began with the placement of crosses out the front of Thornely Hall to signify all those Kerang and District soldiers who died whilst at war or peace keeping duties.

This was followed by a service in the Hall to show our respect for all those who have given us the life we enjoy.

An interesting fact is that the Honour Roll was published in the first Yearbook for Kerang Higher Elementary School was published under the name of Golden Grains in 1920. This book identified some 172 former students of Kerang State School had joined the Armed Forces, and a total of 23 died on Active Service.

Dear Parent/Guardian

A number of our senior school students are driving or intend to drive to school this year and some have indicated that they intend to carry another student as a passenger.

Despite the fact that most young drivers try to be careful, safety conscious and considerate when driving, research clearly shows that they are at a higher risk of having a serious crash than older, more experienced drivers.

The presence of young passengers also greatly increases the risk for teenage drivers and, the more passengers, the greater the risk.

It is important that all students and their parents/guardians are aware of these risks and the type of behaviour that the school expects from student drivers.

Copies of the school Policy on student drivers and the Parent Permission and Student Agreement Form are available upon request.

The policy outlines the school's expectations and provides information regarding the transport of passengers. Of particular note is that student drivers are not permitted to carry other students as passengers to and from school.

Under the Graduated Licensing System, no more than one peer aged passenger (aged 16-22 years) is permitted to travel with the driver, unless the passengers are siblings of the driver. The school requests that only siblings to travel to and from school with the licensed driver. This is based on research that shows that young drivers carrying several passengers are more likely to engage in risk taking behaviour. For more information, go to:

To ensure that all involved are aware of these requirements, student drivers and a parent/guardian are required to sign a Parent Permission and Student Agreement Form.

The form must be signed and returned prior to students using the designated parking area on Burgoyne Street

These requirements are intended to ensure the welfare and safety of students at our school and the local community.
